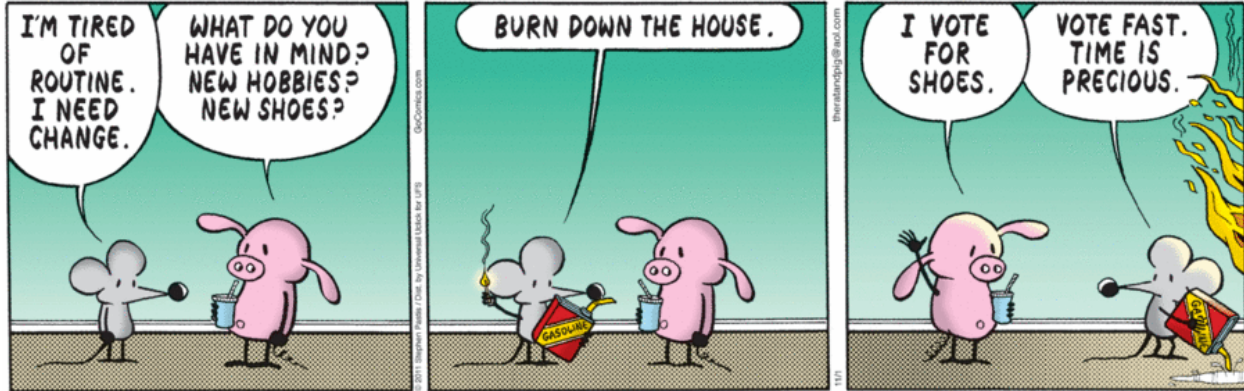




# Natively Speaking Comics
